

## Hume R-VIII School Computer Use Agreement 2019-2020

Students should realize that the use of technology, particularly computers, is a privilege. Therefore, the school administration can and will enforce the rules listed below.

1. No objectionable material will be viewed, downloaded or printed by any student. Objectionable includes games, or anything classified pornographic, violent or obscene in nature. Any site that contains profanity should also be avoided. When in doubt, don't go there!
2. No unauthorized disclosure, use, and dissemination of personal information or no unauthorized and unlawful activities are allowed online.
3. If a questionable site is accidentally displayed, immediately report it to your teacher or adult in charge. If an adult is not there to supervise, you should not be on the computer.
4. Students are not allowed to enter any type of chat room at any time of the day.
5. E-mail is allowed before or after school (only if a teacher agrees to supervise). Students are not to send or check e-mail during the school day, unless it is a part of a class activity.
6. Anyone using the computer in an inappropriate way will lose his/her computer privileges for the rest of the school year. Adult supervision is required for any computer use. There are not exceptions.
7. Anyone who does not sign this agreement and have a parent sign it will not be allowed to use any computers until the signatures are on file in the appropriate office.
8. Absolutely no downloads without teacher approval and supervision.
9. Students are not to change desktop pictures or screen savers on any computers.
10. The computer lab in the library is available for students use when there is a teacher present only. Students must sign in and out of library computer lab.
11. The computer lab laptops are to be checked out by the TEACHER only. Students are not to come get them themselves.
